

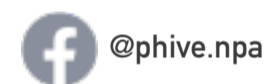


PHIVE

Promoting Heritage in Virtual Environment (PHIVE) will develop a synthesis of 5 EU projects bringing together:

- Virtual Centre of Excellence for using Virtual and Augmented reality to promote and preserve heritage post-COVID; including online live workshops, with accompanying learning materials and virtual tours; to disseminate how we create exemplar virtual reality content for collaborative environments.
- Virtual Time Travel demonstration will provide a framework for live exploration of the past. This will bring together work on Downpatrick site in the STRATUS project and digi-tourist framework in the CINE project.
- Exhibition System based on the International Image interoperability Framework enabling exploration of maps, timelines, virtual tours, objects, and landscapes.
